

One Day interruptions to play due to rain

1. In One Day Games, if there are interruptions to play due to inclement weather, whether in the innings of the side batting first or in the innings of the side batting second, or both, the following Rules shall apply.

2. If the side batting first is dismissed before 10am (whether or not there are interruptions for inclement weather), and irrespective of the number of overs faced by the side batting first:

- (i) A 10 minute innings break shall then be taken.
- (ii) The side batting second shall be entitled to the full 25 overs.
- (iii) If the innings of the side batting second is able to be commenced immediately after the 10 minute innings break and there are no interruptions to play during the innings of the side batting second play shall continue, if required, beyond 11.40am until the side batting second has received its full entitlement of 25 overs or is dismissed beforehand. The winner will be the side that has scored the most runs.
- (iv) If the side batting second has interruptions to play due to inclement weather (and not having been dismissed) does not receive its full entitlement of 25 overs by 11.40am, the match shall cease at 11.40am (if play is still interrupted at 11.40am) or at the end of the last over bowled before 11.40am.
- (v) The match will be a draw unless the side batting second has passed the score made by the side batting first or if the side batting second is dismissed during the last over bowled before 11.40am or earlier.

3. If the innings of the side batting first has been interrupted by inclement weather and it has faced 15 or more overs by 10am and has not been dismissed by 10am:

- (i) Its innings shall be closed at 10am (if play is still interrupted at 10am) or at the end of the last over bowled before 10am.
- (ii) A 10 minute innings break shall then be taken.
- (iii) The innings of the side batting second shall commence at 10.10am if able to, otherwise as soon as possible after the inclement weather interruption ceases.
- (iv) The side batting second shall be entitled to the same number of overs as the side batting first (and no more). If the innings of the side batting second commences at 10.10am and there are no interruptions to play during the innings of the side batting second, play shall continue, if required, beyond 11.40am until the side batting second has received the same number of overs as the side batting first or is otherwise dismissed. The winner will be the side that has scored the most runs.
- (v) If the side batting second has interruptions to play due to inclement weather (and not having been dismissed) does not face the same number of overs by 11.40am as the side batting first, the match shall cease at 11.40am (if play is still interrupted at 11.40am) or at the end of the last over bowled before 11.40am.

(vi) The match will be a draw unless the side batting second has passed the score made by the side batting first or if the side batting second is dismissed during the last over bowled before 11.40am or earlier.

4. If the innings of the side batting first has been interrupted by inclement weather and it has faced less than 15 overs by 10am and has not been dismissed by 10am:

(i) Its innings shall continue (with no tea break at 10am) until it has faced 15 overs (or is dismissed before 15 overs), at which time its innings shall be closed.

(ii) A 10 minute innings break shall then be taken.

(iii) The innings of the side batting second shall then commence if able to, otherwise as soon as possible after the inclement weather interruption ceases.

(iv) The side batting second shall bat until it is dismissed or until 11.40am or until it has received 15 overs, whichever occurs first, at which time the match is at an end.

(v) If the match finishes because the side batting second has been dismissed or received 15 overs, the winner will be the side that has scored the most runs.

(vi) If the match finishes due to time (ie it is 11.40am) the match will be a draw unless the side batting second has passed the score made by the side batting first or if the side batting second is dismissed during the last over bowled before 11.40am.

5. If the inclement weather interruption(s) prevents the side batting first from facing its minimum 15 overs or the side batting second is unable to commence its innings the match will be a draw.
